

Dear Parent/Carer,

We are pleased to inform you that we are able to welcome you back into the building at Nell Gwynn Nursery School from **Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> May**. Please note that **Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> May is a Bank Holiday**, therefore we will be closed for the day.

We ask that from Tuesday, you arrive at your usual entrance where a member of staff will direct you to bring your child(ren) through to their classroom door. Staff in the classroom will welcome them in and settle them. You can depart once your child has entered the classroom.

Buggies/Pushchairs to be parked outside and younger sibling to be walked or carried through. This is for fire safety reasons. Differently abled parents/carers and children who require wheelchairs, buggies or walking aids to access the building will be welcomed through.

In terms of keeping everyone well and safe, please do not bring your child into school if you are unwell or suspect you may have Coronavirus. If your child is well but you are not, then please consider alternate arrangements for bringing and collection. Parents/Carers are welcome to wear face coverings if they so wish, but there is no expectation to.
